Mr. Richard J. Harshman, also known as Rich, has been Chairman Chief Executive Officer of Allegheny Technologies Inc. (ATI) since May 1, 2011 and its President since August 1, 2010. Previously he served as ATI's President and Chief Operating Officer beginning in August 2010. Prior to that, Mr. Harshman served as an Executive Vice President, Finance and Chief Financial Officer and a member of ATI's Executive Management Committee from October 2003 to August 2010. Mr. Harshman began his career with Teledyne, Inc. (a predecessor company to ATI) in 1978.

He serves as a Director of Ameren Corporation; Vice Chair of Allegheny Conference on Community Development; and vice chairman of the board of trustees at Robert Morris University and is a member of the board of directors of the National Association of Manufacturers. He is a member of the board of directors of the Laurel Highlands Council, Boy Scouts of America, Board of Trustees of the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra and the Pittsburgh Cultural Trust Board of Trustees and is Director, Second Vice President and Executive Committee of the Duquesne Club.

Mr. Harshman was named one of the Most Influential People in Business of 2011 by the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette. He was also honored with the Best CFO Award in 2008 by Institutional Investor and named 2008 CFO of the Year (public company category) by the Pittsburgh Business Times. In May 2013, he was the recipient of the AIST (Association for Iron and Steel Technology) William T. Hogan, S.J. Lecture Award. In March 2014, he was honored by the American Red Cross as the recipient of the Distinguished Leadership Award.

Mr. Harshman is a graduate of Robert Morris University. He and his wife, Scheryl, reside in Upper St. Clair, PA and have 3 adult children.





**REX W. TILLERSON**  
**Chairman and Chief Executive Officer**  
**ExxonMobil Corporation**  
**2014 Keynote Speaker**

A native of Wichita Falls, Texas, Rex Tillerson earned a Bachelor of Science degree in civil engineering at the University of Texas at Austin before joining Exxon Company, U.S.A. in 1975 as a production engineer.

In 1989, he became general manager of Exxon Company U.S.A.'s central production division, responsible for oil and gas production operations throughout a large portion of Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas and Kansas.

In 1992, Mr. Tillerson was named production advisor to Exxon Corporation. Three years later he was named president of Exxon Yemen Inc. and Esso Exploration and Production Khorat Inc., and in January 1998 became vice president of Exxon Ventures (CIS) Inc. and president of Exxon Neftegas Limited. In those roles, he was responsible for Exxon's holdings in Russia and the Caspian Sea as well as the Sakhalin I consortium operations offshore Sakhalin Island, Russia.

In December 1999, he became executive vice president of ExxonMobil Development Company. Mr. Tillerson was named senior vice president of Exxon Mobil Corporation in August 2001, and was elected president of the corporation and member of the board of directors on March 1, 2004. He assumed his current position on January 1, 2006.

Mr. Tillerson is a member of the executive committee and a former chairman of the American Petroleum Institute. He is also a member of the Society of Petroleum Engineers and a trustee of the Center for Strategic and International Studies. He is a member of the National Petroleum Council, a member of the Business Roundtable, a member of the Business Council, an honorary trustee of the Business Council for International Understanding, and a member of the Emergency Committee for American Trade. In 2013, Mr. Tillerson was elected to the National Academy of Engineering.

Mr. Tillerson is the vice-chairman of the Ford's Theatre Society, immediate past national president of the Boy Scouts of America, and a former director of the United Negro College Fund. He is also a member of the Chancellor's Council, Development Board and the Engineering Advisory Board for the University of Texas at Austin, where he was named a distinguished alumnus in 2007. In 2011, he received an honorary doctorate engineering degree from the Worcester Polytechnic Institute. In 2013, he was awarded the Order of Friendship by Vladimir Putin, president of the Russian Federation.

## BE SAFE, MAKE THE CALL

Although the natural gas delivery system is extremely safe, it is not infallible. Leaks do occur on occasion, but they usually can be detected in **one of three ways.**



**By Smell**

Because the gas is odorless, a sulfur-based odorant is added to give it a rotten-egg smell that warns of its presence.



**By Sight**

Escaping gas affects the nutrients in soil, so discolored soil or dead vegetation near a pipeline may indicate a leak.



**By Sound**

Natural gas leaks may make a hissing or a high-pitched whistling noise.

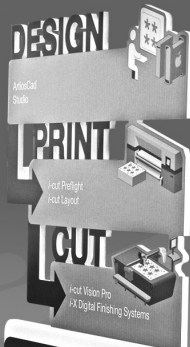

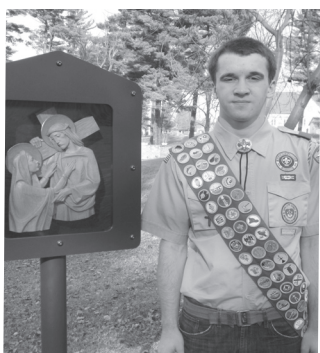

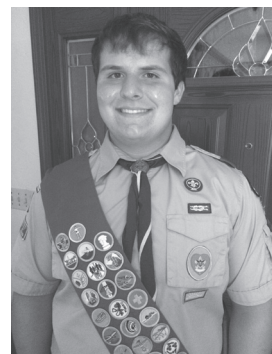

## THE EAGLE SCOUT AWARD

The Eagle Scout Award is the seventh and topmost step in the succession of progress awards issued by the Boy Scouts of America. It represents the highest level of achievement in skill, in service, and in leadership recognized in Scouting.

As with each of the steps in the Boy Scout advancement plan, progress toward the Eagle Scout Award is cumulative. Only those Scouts who have maintained a term of active membership since becoming a Life Scout, demonstrated Scout spirit and leadership, and earned a total of twenty-one elected and required merit badges are eligible to seek the Eagle Scout Award.

Opportunities for individual achievement and recognition are built into the regular Scouting activities of each troop. An Eagle Scout's standing depends to an even greater extent on the way he demonstrates Scouting spirit. His adherence to the Scout Oath and Scout Law is determined through personal review by his Scoutmaster, as well as through recommendations with teachers, clergymen, and other community leaders.

Only upon satisfying the exacting tests of skill, community service and participation in Scouting leadership, may a Scout join the elite few who enter the Scout's Court of Honor to receive the Eagle Scout Award.
